

Where

Mostly flat, wheel-measured course starting at the corner of College Avenue and South Allen Street in Downtown State College, looping through the tree-lined streets of the Penn State campus and finishing on College Avenue near the Wesley Center.

Course Information

The course will be maintained open based on a 45-minute finish time. Runners/walkers at a slower pace should finish on the sidewalk (west side of Shortlidge, north side of College).

Awards

Plaques go to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall male and female runners and 1st and 2nd in the masters (40+) division. Certificates will be given to the top 3 men and women in these age groups: 5–19 in 3-year splits and 20–89 in 5-year splits.

Plaque to best most original costume worn by a runner or group of runners.
